The unit uses minimal data." The wireless connection goes from the CAPXL to the LiftMaster operator. "Using a SIP provider and DHCP internet connection is preferred", McCoy added.

Over twenty dealers participated in one of the two sessions conducted by McCoy, and everyone seemed genuinely interested in the wireless direction access control products are headed, including Nordstrom. "The CAPXL programming is entirely different than what we've seen in the past. It's a perfect time for Encon and LiftMaster to collaborate on a training event like this one. We are educating our dealers on the latest technology on the market, and hopefully alleviating any uneasiness our dealers may have surrounding this new and/or unfamiliar technology."
